

How to Log in to Student Email (Gmail)

From a desktop or laptop computer (non-chromebook)

- 1. Open a web browser, preferably Chrome
- 2. Go to: mail.google.com
 - a. If your browser is already logged into another Google account, sign out.
 - i. To sign out, select the circular icon in the upper-right part of the screen, select Sign out
- 3. On the Google Sign In page, enter the student email address and select Next
 - a. USD email addresses follow this pattern: *firstname.lastname@student.uintah.net*
 - b. If you get an error message of *Couldn't find your Google Account*, double-check the email address to see if it's typed correctly. If it is typed correctly, contact your student's teacher to get the correct email address
- 4. Enter the password in the space provided
 - a. USD student email passwords consist of the student's 5-digit student number (lunch number) with three zeros on the end (example, 12345000)
- 5. After entering the password, the email app (Gmail) should open and show the Inbox

Using a USD chromebook

- 1. Open the chromebook and if it's connected to a wireless network the Sign In page will show
- 2. On the Google Sign In page, enter the student email address and select Next
 - a. USD Google email addresses follow this pattern: firstname.lastname@student.uintah.net
 - b. If you get an error message of *Couldn't find your Google Account*, double-check the email address to see if it's typed correctly. If it is typed correctly, contact your student's teacher to get the correct email address
- 3. Enter the password in the space provided
 - a. USD student email passwords consist of the student's 5-digit student number with three zeros on the end (example, 12345000)
- 4. Once logged into the chromebook, go to the email app (Gmail). Here are two ways:
 - a. Click in the URL space at the top of the page (called the Omnibox) and type: mail.google.com, or
 - b. Click on the Google menu icon found towards the upper-right part of the screen and then select the Gmail app (the Google menu icon is made of 9 dots forming a square; looks like a rubik's cube)
- 5. The email app (Gmail) should open and show the Inbox
